Selection Criteria

Nominations close at 5pm, Wednesday 31 March 2021

- Project must have been completed between January 2019 and December 2020
- Project must have had benefit outside of fundraising accomplishments
- Nominating clubs are required to submit the Required Attachments outlined below

Required Attachments

- Project Plan and any evidence of the project such as media attention, grant applications, and meeting notes **Maximum 3 attachments**
- At least one (1) high resolution photo of the project or people involved suitable for display on the large screen at the Awards Ceremony **Maximum 3 attachments**
- Video footage of the project (optional but preferred)
