



Clubs WA Industry Awards for Excellence 2020/21

Terms and Conditions of Entry



Clubs WA Incorporated (Clubs WA) thanks you for considering nominating for the Clubs WA Industry Awards for Excellence 2020/21. The following Terms and Conditions of Entry apply to all entrants in all Award categories. Clubs WA has the right to disqualify you or declare your entry ineligible if you do not comply with these terms.

- A nominating club must be a financial member of Clubs WA at the time of nomination.
- Information provided in your submissions must only be from the qualifying period (January 1 2019 - December 31 2020). With the exception of the 'Lifetime Contribution to Volunteering' Award, judges will not take into consideration achievements outside this duration.
- Clubs WA reserves the right to honour the achievement of any club that has won the same category for a number of consecutive years by inducting them into the Hall of Fame. Inductees will not be eligible to nominate in that category for a specified duration.
- Split-premises clubs, whether as a result of amalgamation or split-premise, are to enter the Awards in their own right and submit independent entries. Where a split-premise club is the recipient of an award, any promotional material related to that award must refer only to the split-premise club and not the amalgamated group to which it belongs to.
- Clubs WA has the right to withdraw and replace award categories from year to year as well as amend dates for submissions and the gala event.
- In consideration of Clubs WA accepting their entry, the entrant indemnifies Clubs WA against all claims, losses, suits and demands made against or suffered by the club, due to any negligent act of omission on the part of the entrant. Clubs WA, its staff, judges, sponsors, transport companies and the like cannot be held responsible for any damages and/or loss of materials that are submitted as an entry.
- If at any time following submission of entry, the club being put forward goes into winding up, receivership, liquidation or bankruptcy, the entrant is required to advise Clubs WA and accepts that the submission will no longer be eligible for an award.
- Clubs WA and its appointed judges will hold all information supplied by nominating clubs and individuals in the strictest of confidence.
- At the judges' discretion, Highly Commended awards may also be given to entries that do not win their category yet demonstrate outstanding achievements or great innovation.
- The entrant agrees to abide by the final decision of the judges and understands that no additional correspondence will be entered into and/or considered. Clubs may seek feedback in general on their award submission, however under no circumstances will the judges be held responsible for any comment, viewpoint or expression, whether expressed or implied, concerning the standard or quality of an entrant's submission.
- Clubs WA may use any photographs submitted by entrants to promote the Awards for Excellence to the media and community. Your contact details may be supplied to Clubs WA approved third parties for promotional/media purposes.
- In extenuating circumstances Clubs WA may grant extensions to clubs, but only if sufficient prior notice is given and approved by the Awards Committee.
- Finalist Clubs in the Clubs WA 2020/21 Awards for Excellence are to have a representative of their club in attendance at the gala event (Date TBC June 2021) to accept the award on stage, should the club be announced the winner.
- The entrant agrees that in the 12-month period following the awards, should any action be brought against the club that may bring discredit to the Clubs WA Awards for Excellence, any award that has been presented, will be revoked.
- Clubs WA has the right to relocate clubs to the appropriate categories where required. Where applicable, when submitting your nominations, you will be required to disclose your approximate most recent annual turnover amount. Clubs WA reserves the right to request evidence of any submissions.
- Submissions close 5pm 31 March 2021. Submissions received by Clubs WA at the time of closing will count as the FINAL submission.
- Clubs WA may, at its discretion, accept submissions after the time of closing.
