

## Terms and Conditions

- 1. The Promoter is Clubs WA Incorporated, Unit 2, 12 Hammond Road, Cockburn Central WA 6164 ABN 72 624 936 996.*
- 2. The Agency is Crown Perth, Great Eastern Highway, Burswood WA 6100 ABN 24 078 250 307*
- 3. Employees of the promoter and agency associated with this promotion are ineligible to enter the competition, as are their immediate families.*
- 4. All entries become and remain the property of the promoter and agency associated with this promotion*

#### **Schedule 5 Conditions for trade promotion lottery**

1. *There must be no cost to enter the lottery.*
